You will have a permanent role from day one. The Programme has been designed to prepare you for a future leadership role. This is a four year apprenticeship programme offering both formal learning and experience which gives you the opportunity to achieve a fully funded Degree qualification whilst working.

Formal learning

The Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship is designed in collaboration with the Chartered Management Institute (CMI) and a range of employers to provide you with the knowledge and skills you need to become a confident manager and leader. You will attend formal training sessions as part of the requirement to provide apprentices with 20% off the job training.

Upon successful completion of your apprenticeship you will achieve a Degree in Management and Business and will be able to apply for professional recognition as a Member of the Chartered Management Institute.

Learn through experience

You'll work across many areas of TfGM with our experienced and dedicated teams, experiencing structured placements in our operational and corporate functions.

You will learn to manage projects; find solutions to real business challenges; contribute to developing strategies to tackle the critical long-term challenges facing Greater Manchester's growing population and economy; find new ways to impact positively on our customers; gain experience in financial management; build strong relationships working with our partners and stakeholders; develop your leadership skills across a number of placements with the aim of taking up a management role at the end of the programme.

Throughout the programme you will receive coaching from experienced managers, a dedicated mentor and buddy. You will have the opportunity to develop relationships with senior leaders, peers, external partners and teams who will support you as your career with TfGM develops.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

You will have (or be expected to achieve) a minimum of 2 A levels equating to 104 UCAS tariff points or equivalent qualifications. You will also require Maths and English Language GCSE grade A*-C /5-9.

You will have strong analytical reasoning skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills, the ability to organise and schedule your time effectively, effective team working and a commitment to your own personal development.

Whilst you will be given time off to complete the formal learning elements of the apprenticeship there will also be a requirement to commit some of your own time to complete your studies.

You must also be a resident within the Greater Manchester boundary.
