Responsible to: Head of Department, SLT, Head of School

Key purpose of the job

To assist curriculum leaders and teachers to deliver safe and successful practical lessons in Design Technology.

Key responsibilities

- To prepare equipment and materials, including handouts required for demonstrations and for practical work, along with dismantling and storage after use.
- To assist students and teaching staff with classroom practicals and demonstrations.
- To liaise with teaching staff to support their timetables within a range of KS3 and KS4 classes.
- To construct and/or modify simple teaching aids.
- To be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of all faculty areas, advising on any improvements which can be made in this respect.
- To maintain all the necessary equipment and consumable resources to deliver practical lessons as required by the department, in a safe environment.
- To maintain a good stock of necessary materials including operating and administering stock control, ordering procedures, preparation of requisitions, obtaining quotations, checking deliveries, etc.
- To operate departmental documentation systems (cataloguing, filing, worksheets, etc.)
- To support the Head of Department with ensuring that all COSHH, HACCP, Risk Assessment, Food Hygiene, Health and Safety Policies and Procedures along with other relevant legislation are met.
- Comply with all statutory requirements in relation to Health & Safety and be aware of the schools Health & Safety Policy.
